

The HUGH H. MACKAY - JAMES A. MACMURRAY scholarships are open to residents of the Province of New Brunswick who will graduate from high school in May/June of the year of application and who intend to enroll in a New Brunswick or Nova Scotia University in the fall of the same year.

Scholarships will be awarded, each with a minimum value of \$3,500.00 per year for each of the four years of the student's degree programme.

CRITERIA

They must, in addition, ensure that the Registrar's Office sends to the Secretary of the Mackay - MacMurray Scholarship Fund copies of the official academic transcripts. Satisfactory progress towards the degree will assure renewal. Scholarships may be held for a maximum of 4 years.
